Terms and Conditions of Appointment

- Term of appointment: 3 years commencing on the date the Warrant of Appointment is signed by the King's Representative
- Salary: \$130,000.00 base per annum
- Superannuation: the Employer's subsidy as determined from time to time by the applicable superannuation scheme
- Motor vehicle: use of motor vehicle and/or transport allowance
- Telephone: use of a mobile phone provided by the Office and all calls to be paid by the Office, except overseas personal calls
- Study allowance: for further studies that are relevant to the work of the Audit Office, will be paid fully provided that there is such an appropriation for such
- Leave entitlements: as per Cook Islands Government Leave Policy (20 days annual leave and 10 days sick leave)
