KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE SOLOMONS GOVERNMENT CURRENCY
NOTES REGULATION 1916.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the
Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in
Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of
God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland
and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender
of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Government Currency
Notes (Amendment) Regulation 1923.

SHORT TITLE.

2. Subsection four of section twelve of the Solomons Currency
Notes Regulation 1916 hereinafter called the principal Regulation
is hereby amended and shall be read as if between the words
"up" and "an" in the third line thereof the words "and publish
in the Gazette" were inserted.

AMENDMENT OF
SUBSECTION 4 OF
SECTION 12 OF
NO. 10 OF 1916.

3. Subsection six of section twelve of the principal Regulation
is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

REPEAL OF
SUBSECTION 6 OF
SECTION 12 OF
NO. 10 OF 1916
AND SUBSTITU-
TION OF NEW
SUBSECTION.

"(6) The annual statement shall after being audited and
"certified correct be published in the Gazette."
