**AN ACT**

**TO AMEND THE 1995 APPROPRIATION ACT, 1994 PROVIDING FOR THE ALTERATION OF AMOUNTS OR SUMS OF MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR CERTAIN HEADS OF EXPENDITURES**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Fiji—

*Short title*

1. This Act may be cited as the 1995 Appropriation (Amendment) (No. 3) Act, 1995.
