COMMERCE COMMISSION DECREE
(DECREE NO. 49 OF 2010)

**Commerce (Control of Ex-Factory Prices for the
Wholesale Supply of Butter) Order 2010**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon the Commerce Commission in accordance with section 39 of the Commerce Commission Decree 2010 (Decree No. 49), I make this Order—

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Commerce (Control of Prices for the Wholesale Supply of Butter) Order 2010 and comes into force on 25th October 2010.

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of this Order, these words have the following meanings—
“butter” refers to butter manufactured and supplied locally and does not include imported butter;
“ex-factory prices” refers to the prices of goods charged by wholesalers from the factory.

Price Control

3. For the purpose of section 39 of the Decree, the ex-factory prices of butter in wholesale supply is controlled.

Expiration of Order

4. This Order expires three years from the date of this Order is made unless it is varied, extended or earlier revoked.
