MINISTERIAL ASSIGNMENT

To : Mr Semi Tuleca Koroilavesau
Minister for Employment, Productivity and Industrial Relations

IN exercise of the powers vested in me as Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby revoke with effect from 10 October 2015 all assignments and responsibilities under Legal Notice No.55 of 2014 and with effect from 16 October 2015 assign to you in your capacity as Minister for Employment, Productivity and Industrial Relations the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government business, departments and written laws specified in Legal No.85 of 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby revoke with effect from 1 January 2016, all assignments and responsibilities under Legal Notice No. 85 of 2015, and with effect from the same day assign to you in your capacity as the Minister for Employment, Productivity and Industrial Relations the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government business, departments and written laws (subject to the provisions of any other written law)—
