PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1935

Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Infringement Notices) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2022

IN exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 82C and 83 of the Public Health Act 1935, I hereby make these Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Infringement Notices) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 2022.

(2) These Regulations come into force on the date of publication in the Gazette.

(3) In these Regulations, the Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2021 is referred to as the “Principal Regulations”.

Regulation 23D inserted

2. The Principal Regulations are amended after regulation 23C by inserting the following new regulation—

“Approved testing facility

23D. Any person that fails to comply with an order in relation to—

- (a) the requirement to undergo testing for COVID-19 at an approved testing facility; or
- (b) the requirement for an approved testing facility to notify the Permanent Secretary for Health and Medical Services if a person who made a booking for a test for COVID-19 with the facility has failed to undergo the test,

commits a fixed penalty offence.”.

Schedule 1 amended

3. Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended after the row in relation to the Protocol for COVID-Safe Operations for Independent Event Halls and Hire Venues by inserting the following new row—

Regulation	Fixed penalty offence	Maximum Penalty: Fine Imprisonment	Fixed penalty for natural persons	Fixed penalty for persons other than natural persons	
"23D	Failure to comply with an order in relation to an approved testing facility	\$10,000 5 years	\$1,000	\$1,000".
