

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-54, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-56, 11-63, 11-67, 11-73 and 12-1, by further amending section 16, as amended by Public Law No. 11-63, to clarify a line item description; by further amending section 19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-56, 11-67, 11-73 and 12-1, to make technical corrections to eliminate allottees for projects previously line-item vetoed; and to extend the lapse date for several CIP projects; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1.   Section 16 of Public Law No. 11-54, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 11-63, is hereby further amended to read as  
3 follows:

4                   "Section 16.   Capital development.   The sum of  
5                   \$1,133,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
6                   hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
7                   Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
8                   ending September 30, 2001, for capital improvement and  
9                   development programs and projects.   Of the total funds  
10                  appropriated under this section, \$1,001,600 shall be  
11                  deemed to come from capital account funds available  
12                  under section 211 of the Compact of Free Association.

13                  The sum appropriated by this section shall be  
14                  apportioned as follows:

12 Section 2. Section 19 of Public Law No. 11-54, as amended by  
13 Public Laws Nos. 11-56, 11-67, 11-73 and 12-1, is hereby further  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 "Section 19. Allotment and management of funds and  
16 lapse date.

17 (1) *General Provisions.*

18 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
19 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
20 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
21 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

22 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
23 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
24 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in  
25 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess

1 of the sum appropriated.

2 (c) No purchase order or contract for the  
3 purchase of a fixed asset with a value of \$1,000 or more  
4 shall be approved until the property inventory records  
5 of the requesting entity are updated, current, and on  
6 file with the Department of Finance and Administration,  
7 in accordance with law.

8 (d) No purchase order or contract for the  
9 purchase of photocopying equipment, computers, or  
10 vehicles shall be approved until the requesting  
11 department or branch of government has on file, with the  
12 Department of Finance and Administration, a plan for the  
13 centralized maintenance of such equipment, computers and  
14 vehicles.

15 (2) *Specific provisions.* Within section 15, the funds  
16 appropriated to Pohnpei State under subsection (2) of  
17 this act and the funds appropriated to Chuuk State under  
18 subsection (3) of this act shall be retained in the  
19 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia until  
20 a scholarship recipient is identified to the President  
21 or the President's designee, at which time scholarship  
22 funds in the amount of the scholarship award shall be  
23 disbursed directly to the educational institution in the  
24 form of a two-party check payable to both the  
25 scholarship recipient and the educational institution he

1 or she is attending.

2 (3) *Allottees*. The allottees of the funds  
3 appropriated by this act are as follows:

4 (a) section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall  
5 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

6 (b) section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall  
7 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States  
8 of Micronesia;

9 (c) section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall  
10 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
11 Federated States of Micronesia;

12 (d) section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall  
13 be the Public Auditor;

14 (e) sections 6 through 16 - the allottee of these  
15 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
16 Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT for the  
17 following subsections of sections 6 through 16 of this  
18 act, the allottees shall be:

19 (i) section 8, subsection (4) - the allottee  
20 of these funds shall be the Governor of the respective  
21 State, or his designee;

22 (ii) section 8, subsection (7)(a), (b), (c)  
23 and (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief  
24 Justice of the respective State;

25 (iii) section 13, subsection (2) - the

1 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
2 College of Micronesia-FSM;

3 (iv) section 15, subsections (1), (2), (3)  
4 and (4) - the allottee of these funds shall be the  
5 Governor of the respective State;

6 (v) section 16, subsection (8)(a) - the  
7 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of Yap  
8 State;

9 (vi) section 16, subsection (8)(b) - the  
10 allottee of these funds shall be the Chuuk State  
11 Commission on Improvement Projects.

12 (4) *Lapse date.* The authority of the allottees to  
13 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as  
14 of September 30, 2001; EXCEPT THAT the authority of the  
15 allottee to obligate funds appropriated under subsection  
16 (1) of section 16 for Staff Upgrading, under subsection  
17 (8)(b) of section 16 for Faichuk Pharmaceutical and  
18 Health Center, and under subsection (10) of section 16  
19 for the Public Auditor's office building shall lapse as  
20 of September 30, 2002, and the authority of the allottee  
21 to obligate funds appropriated by section 15(4) for post  
22 secondary assistance for the State of Yap shall not  
23 lapse."

1           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
