**PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-54**

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AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$1,898,486 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-26 and 18-41, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

2           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by  
3 Public Laws Nos. 18-26 and 18-41, is hereby further amended to  
4 read as follows:

5           "Section 1. Title. The title of this act is as  
6 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$58,521,997 from the  
7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
8 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the  
9 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the  
10 National Government of the Federated States of  
11 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,  
12 subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human  
13 Resources Development. Of the total amount of funds  
14 appropriated herein, \$2,437,568 shall be deemed to come  
15 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the  
16 education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from  
17 funds available under the Amended Compact from the  
18 health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds  
19 available under the Amended Compact from the

1           infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from  
2           funds available under the Amended Compact from the  
3           public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed to  
4           come from funds available under the Amended Compact from  
5           the enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and  
6           \$1,112,158 shall be deemed to come from funds available  
7           under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum  
8           appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

9           Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by  
10          Public Law No. 18-41, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11           "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive  
12           Branch. The sum of \$17,699,045, or so much thereof as  
13           may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
14           General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
15           the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the  
16           purpose of funding the operations of the Executive  
17           Branch of the National Government during the fiscal  
18           year 2014. Of the total amount of funds appropriated  
19           herein, \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds  
20           available under the Amended Compact from the education  
21           sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds  
22           available under the Amended Compact from the health  
23           sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds  
24           available under the Amended Compact from the  
25           infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come

1 from funds available under the Amended Compact from the  
2 enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and  
3 \$312,492 shall be deemed to come from funds available  
4 under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum  
5 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
6 follows:

3           Section 7.    Section 13 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended  
4 by Public Law No. 18-41, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5           "Section 13. Allotment and management of funds and  
6           lapse dates.

7           (1) General provisions.

8                   (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
9                   allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
10                   accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
11                   limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

12                   (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
13                   ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
14                   necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified  
15                   in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in  
16                   excess of the sums appropriated.

17           (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds  
18           appropriated by this act are as follows:

19                   (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds  
20                   shall be the President of the Federated States of  
21                   Micronesia;

22                   (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds  
23                   shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
24                   States of Micronesia;

25                   (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds

1 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
2 Federated States of Micronesia;

3 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds  
4 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
5 Micronesia;

6 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
7 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
8 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following  
9 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

10 (i) Section 8(6)(g) - the allottee shall be  
11 the President of the College of Micronesia - FSM; and

12 (ii) Section 8, (13)(a) through (d) - the  
13 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of  
14 the respective State Supreme Court;

15 (iii) Section 8 (10)(a) through (d) - the  
16 allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the  
17 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; and

18 (iv) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the  
19 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
20 College of Micronesia-FSM;

21 (v) Section 8(4)(q) - the allottee of these  
22 funds shall be the Governor of Yap State.

23 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to  
24 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as  
25 of September 30, 2014; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the

1 funds appropriated under section 9 of this act shall  
2 not lapse.

3 Section 8. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
5 becoming law without such approval.
