**PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-94**

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 19-89, by amending sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the states of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

2           Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-89, is hereby  
3 amended to read as follow:

4           "Section 2. Of the sum of \$1,400,000 appropriated by  
5 this act, \$200,000 is apportioned for public projects  
6 and social programs in the state of Yap.

14 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-89 is hereby  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 "Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. All  
17 funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
18 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance  
19 with  
20 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the  
21 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be  
22 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much  
23 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the  
24 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations  
25 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The

1 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of  
2 this act shall be the Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED  
3 THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
4 subsection 2(b) of this act shall be the President of  
5 the COM-FSM. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
6 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of  
7 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;  
8 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
9 subsections 3(a), 3(b), 3(c), 3(d), 3(e) 3(f), 3(g),  
10 3(h), 3(l) and 3(m) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town  
11 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
12 subsections 3(i), 3(j) and 3(k) shall be the Mayor of  
13 Tafunsak Municipal Government; the allottee of funds  
14 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a) shall be the  
15 Mayor of Kolonia Town Government or his designee; the  
16 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c)  
17 shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of  
18 Education or her designee; the allottee of funds  
19 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(b), 4(2)(d),  
20 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(4)(a), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(c), 4(4)(d) and  
21 4(4)(e) shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
22 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his  
23 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
24 subsection 4(3)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
25 Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under

1 subsection 4(4)(f) shall be the Pohnpei Utility  
2 Corporation. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
3 subsections 5(1), 5(3), 5(4)(e) and 5(6) of this act  
4 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee;  
5 PROVIDED THAT; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
6 subsection 5(3)(d) of this act shall be Secretary of the  
7 Department of Finance and Administration or her  
8 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
9 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock  
10 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
11 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be  
12 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The  
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of  
14 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.  
15 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
16 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,  
17 2018.

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1           Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
