

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 19-170, by amending section 2 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the state of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-170 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. Of the sum of \$200,000 appropriated by
4 this act, \$50,000 is apportioned for public projects
5 and social programs in the state of Yap.

7 (a) Yap Traditional Navigation
8 Society (TNS) 10,000

9 (b) Waa' gey 10,000

10 (c) Yap Saint Mary's school repair
11 and maintenance 20,000

1 Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-170 is hereby amended to read
2 as follows:

3 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds
4 and lapse date. All funds appropriated by this
5 act shall be allotted, managed, administered and
6 accounted for in accordance with applicable
7 laws, including, but not limited to, the
8 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee
9 shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
11 are used solely for the purpose specified in
12 this act, and that no obligations are incurred
13 in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee
14 of the funds appropriated under section 2 of
15 this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or
16 his designee. The allottee of funds
17 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
18 shall be the President of the Federated States
19 of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT,
20 the allottee of funds appropriated under
21 subsection 3(a) of this act shall be the Mayor
22 of Utwe Municipal Government or his designee.
23 The allottee of funds appropriated under section
24 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
25 State or his designee. The authority of the

1 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this
2 act shall lapse on September 30, 2018.

3 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
5 becoming law without such approval.
