

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$4,200,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
3 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
4 ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding public
5 projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae,
6 Pohnpei and Chuuk States. The fund shall be apportioned as
7 follows:

8 Section 2. Of the sum of \$4,200,000 appropriated by this
9 act, \$600,000 is apportioned for Yap State for public projects
10 and social programs.

24 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 25 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,

1 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
2 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
3 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
4 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
6 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
7 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
8 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his
9 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3
10 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the
12 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) to 3(n)
13 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
14 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
15 3(o) to 3(v) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak
16 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(f), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l),
18 4(1)(m), 4(2)(b) and 4(2)(c) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
19 Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
21 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i) and 4(2)(j) shall be the
22 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications
23 and Infrastructure or his designee. The allottee of funds
24 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act
25 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The
