

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33 and 20-48, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4. Section 4 of Public Law No. 19-124,  
2 as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33  
3 and 20-48, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this  
5 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority  
6 infrastructure projects and other programs in the state  
7 of Pohnpei.

14 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by  
 15 Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33 and 20-48, is  
 16 hereby further amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 18 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 19 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 20 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
 21 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 22 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
 23 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
 24 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
 25 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum

1           appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
2           under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the  
3           State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds  
4           appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be  
5           the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or  
6           his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds  
7           appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and 3(1)(b) of  
8           this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his  
9           designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
10          subsections 4(1)(c) through 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(k),  
11          4(3)(q), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(af), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d) and  
12          4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority  
13          (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
14          subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),  
15          4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i), 4(2)(j) and 4(3)(x) shall be  
16          the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
17          Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the  
18          allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
19          4(3)(f), 4(3)(i), 4(3)(q) 4(3)(w) and 4(3)(aa) of this  
20          act shall be the Luhk en Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee  
21          of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ad) of this  
22          act shall be the Chief Justice of Madolenihmw or his  
23          designee, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
24          subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Chief  
25          Justice of Kitti or his designee. The allottee of the

1 funds appropriated under section 5 of this act shall be  
2 the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The  
3 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated  
4 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2019."

5 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
7 becoming law without such approval.
