

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$9,800,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The sum of \$9,800,000, or so much thereof as may  
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
4 September 30, 2019, for the purpose of funding public projects and  
5 social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk  
6 states. The funds appropriated under this section shall be  
7 apportioned as follows:

8           Section 2. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this act,  
9 \$1,400,000 shall be apportioned for public projects and social  
10 programs for the people of Yap State.

21 Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.  
 22 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,  
 23 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,  
 24 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of  
 25 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these

1 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for  
2 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
3 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the  
4 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the  
5 Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
6 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of  
7 Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds  
8 appropriated under subsection 3(ad) of this act shall be the  
9 President of COM-FSM or his designee. The allottee of funds  
10 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President of  
11 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT  
12 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(q) of  
13 this act shall be the President of COM-FSM or his designee; the  
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(s) of this  
15 act shall be the Mayor of Madolenhimw Municipal Government or his  
16 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
17 4(1)(t) of this act shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State or his  
18 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
19 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the Secretary of  
20 the Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee; the  
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and  
22 4(3)(e) of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
23 Education or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated  
24 under subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(j)  
25 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of

1 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;  
2 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(k) of  
3 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources and  
4 Development or his designee; The allottee of the funds  
5 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act  
6 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee  
7 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall  
8 be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee  
9 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall  
10 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of  
11 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be  
12 the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the allottee  
13 to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
14 September 30, 2020.

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1           Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
