CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 6-133, C.D.1

Public Law No. 6 - 31

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-28, Truk State public projects, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended, for the purpose of modifying the use of the funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, 4-67, 4-97, 4-112, 5-10 and 5-130, is  
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:
