Public Law No. 6 - 63

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-95, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-30, 5-44, 5-51, 5-82, 5-107 and 5-131, for the purpose of changing the uses of funds for certain Chuuk State public projects, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by Public


