**AN ACT TO AMEND THE PRIVILEGES, IMMUNITIES AND POWERS  
OF THE MANEABA NI MAUNGATABU ACT 1986.**

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Privileges, Immunities and Powers of the Maneaba ni Maungatabu (Amendment) Act 2007*.

**2. Amendment of Schedule 3**

The *Privileges, Immunities and Powers of the Maneaba ni Maungatabu Act 1986* is amended by repealing Schedule 3 and substituting the following—

**PRECINCTS OF THE MANEABA**

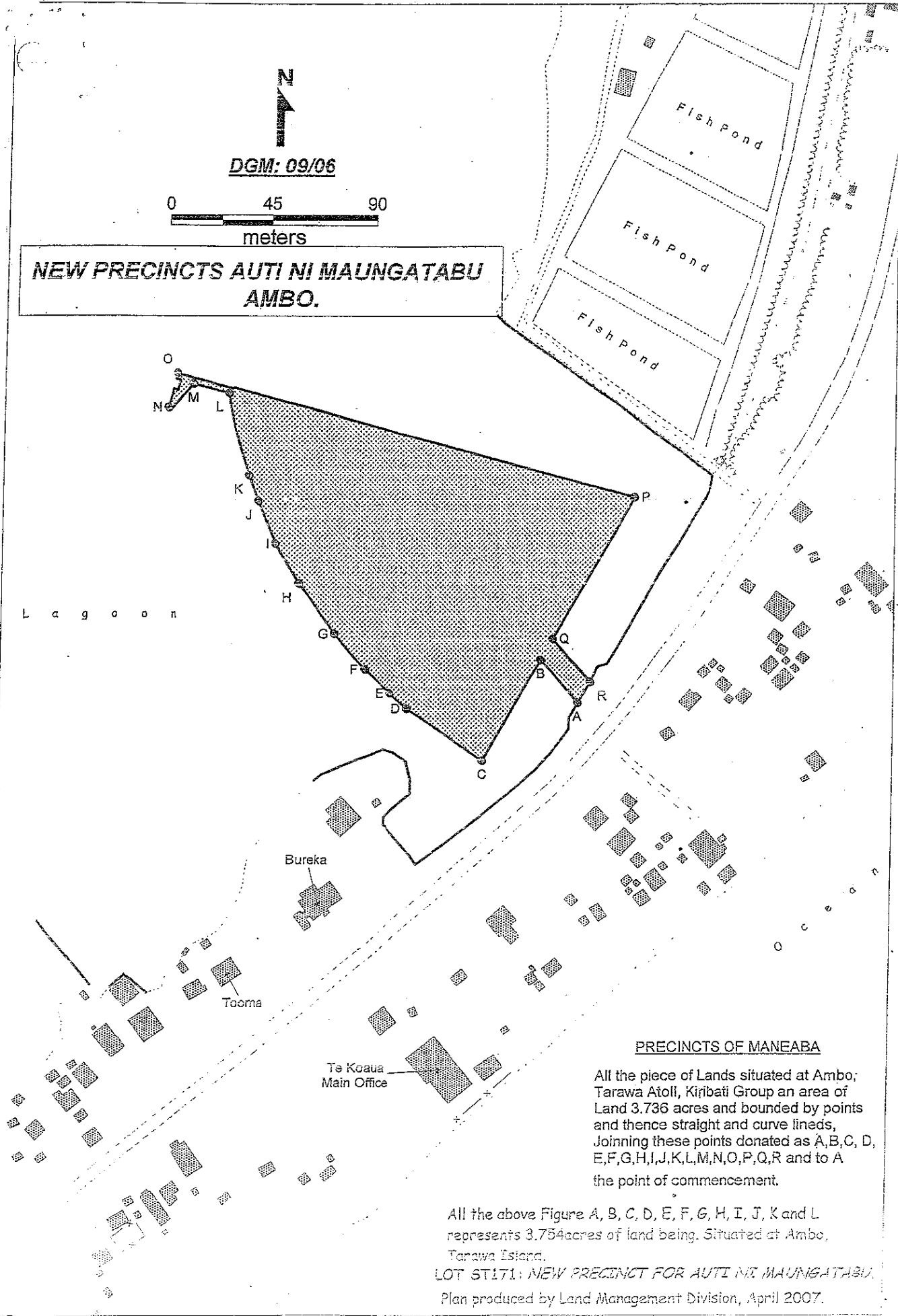
