**AN ACT TO AUTHORISE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION  
OF MONIES OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR  
RECURRENT EXPENDITURE FOR THE SERVICE OF  
THE YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER 1994**

**Commencement:**  
**1995**

**MADE** by the Maneaba ni Maungatabu and assented to by the Beretitenti.

**Short title and commencement**

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1995 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 November 1994.

**Authorisation of issue of \$630,000 from the Consolidated Fund**

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$630,000 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending December 1994.

**Appropriation**

3. The sum specified in Section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.





**SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT 1995**

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

1. This Act seeks to charge upon the Consolidated Fund the appropriation of monies (\$630,000) required for recurrent expenditure in respect of the months, November and December 1994.
2. This is achieved by giving the Act a retrospective effect to 1 November 1994.
3. This Act is presented to the Maneaba ni Maungatabu in accordance with the requirements of Section 109(3) of the Constitution.
