AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTORY SALARIES  
ORDINANCE BY ADJUSTING THE SALARIES  
PAYABLE TO THE SCHEDULED OFFICERS.

Commencement: 1 January, 1980

MADE by the Maneaba ni Maungatabu and assented to by the Beretitenti.

Its title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutory Salaries (Amendment) Act, 1980, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on January 1, 1979.

Its section of Ordinance 4 of 1977.

2. Section 2 of the Statutory Salaries Ordinance (in this Act referred to as the principal Act) is amended by repealing the words "Senior Magistrate" in sub-section (2) and substituting the words "Chief Justice".

Its title and commencement.

3. The Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and the following Schedule substituted:-

SCHEDULE.

Column 1	Column 2
Speaker	\$7,824 per annum.
Chief Justice	\$7,428 per annum.
Attorney-General	\$7,428 per annum.
Director of Audit	\$7,200 per annum.
Commissioner of Police	\$7,200 per annum.
Chairman, Public Service Commission	\$7,512 per annum.
Member, Public Service Commission	A fee of \$10 for each day (or part of each day) on which he attends a meeting of the Public Service Commission.
