AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RIGHTS OF ALIENS WITH RESPECT TO PROPERTY.

I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact, order and proclaim as under :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Aliens Ordinance* 1935, and shall come into operation forthwith.

2. In this Ordinance—

“ Native ” means an aboriginal of the Island of Nauru, and includes an aboriginal native of China or of any Island of the Pacific Ocean, or of any of the East Indian Islands, or of Malaysia and any person who is wholly or partly descended from any such aboriginal native.

3. This Ordinance shall not apply in respect of Natives.

4.—(1) Real and personal property of every description may be taken, acquired, held and disposed of by any person who is not a natural born British subject in the same manner in all respects as a natural-born British subject, and a title to real and personal property of every description may be derived through, from or in succession to such person in the same manner in all respects as if he were a natural-born British subject.

(2) A person who is not a natural-born British subject shall not be entitled under this section to any right or privilege except such rights and privileges in respect of property as are thereby expressly given to him.
