

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LAWS REPEAL AND ADOPTING ORDINANCE 1922-1933.

I, the Administrator, of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact, order and proclaim as under :—

- 1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1935*, and shall come into operation forthwith.
 - (2) The *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1922-1933* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
 - (3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1922-1935*.
2. Section one of the *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1933* is amended by omitting sub-section (2.).
 3. The first Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended—
 - (a) by omitting the words “ *Copyright Act 1912* ” and inserting in their stead the words “ *Copyright Act 1912-1933* ”;
 - (b) by omitting the words “ *Designs Act 1906-1912* ” and inserting in their stead the words “ *Designs Act 1906-1934* ”;
 - (c) by omitting the words “ *Patents Act 1903-1909* ” and inserting in their stead the words “ *Patents Act 1903-1934* ”;
 - (d) by omitting the words “ *Trade Marks Act 1905-1919* ” and inserting in their stead the words “ *Trade Marks Act 1905-1934* ”; and
 - (e) by inserting, after the words “ *Patents, Trade Marks and Designs Act 1914-1915* ” the words “ *Patents, Trade Marks and Designs Act 1932* ”.
