

THE ISLAND OF NAURU.

No. 2 of 1946.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Registration of Australian Patents Ordinance 1925.

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom, His Majesty's Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and His Majesty's Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, as follows:-

Short title and citation. 1.-(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Australian Patents Ordinance 1946.

(2.) The Registration of Australian Patents Ordinance 1925, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Registration of Australian Patents Ordinance 1925-1946.

2. After section three of the Registration of Australian Patents Ordinance 1925 the following section is inserted:-

Extension of time for the receipt of applications.

"3A. In any case where, because of the occupation of Nauru by enemy forces, application for registration of a patent could not be made within the time specified in the last preceding section, the Administrator may extend the time within which an application may be made for registration for a period not exceeding three years calculated from the first day of January, 1946."
