## 3 Irrecoverable debts written off



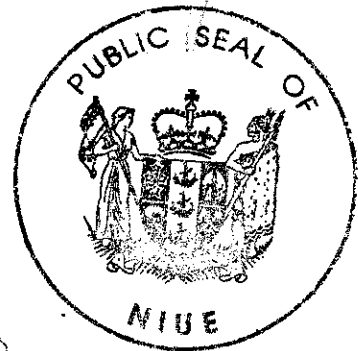
