**AN ORDINANCE**

To Amend the "Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1924."

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1930.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Ordinance the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1924*, is referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1930.*

**2.** This Ordinance shall commence on the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one. Commencement.

**3.** Part II of the Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following Part inserted in its stead:— Postal articles.

"PART II—POSTAL ARTICLES.

FIRST COLUMN. Postal Articles.	SECOND COLUMN. Rates of Postage.
Letters and Letter Cards ...	2d. for every ounce or fraction thereof.
Post Cards (single) ...	1½d. each.
Post Cards (with reply paid) ...	1½d. each half.
Printed Papers, as prescribed ...	1d. for every 2 ounces or fraction thereof.
Books printed outside the Territory or Australia, except as prescribed ...	1d. for every 4 ounces or fraction thereof.
Books printed in the Territory or Australia except as prescribed...	1d. for every 8 ounces or fraction thereof.
Magazines, that is to say—	
(a) Magazines, reviews, and other similar publications wholly set up and printed in the Territory or Australia and published for sale in numbers at intervals not exceeding three months ...	1d. for every 8 ounces or fraction thereof.
(b) Magazines, reviews, and other similar publications not wholly set up and printed in the Territory or Australia and published for sale in numbers at intervals not exceeding three months	1d. for every 4 ounces of fraction thereof.
<i>Hansard</i> , that is reports of Parliamentary debates printed and published by the authority of the Commonwealth or of a State or of a Territory ...	1d. for every 12 ounces or fraction thereof.
Commercial papers, patterns, samples and merchandise, as prescribed ...	1d. for every 2 ounces or fraction thereof.
