AN ORDINANCE

To appropriate a Sum not exceeding Ten Thousand and Eighty-nine Pounds Sixteen Shillings and One Penny to the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In addition to the sums authorised by the *Appropriation Ordinance, 1916-1917*, there shall and may be issued and applied for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and seventeen for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the sums in the said Schedule respectively set forth amounting to Ten Thousand and Eighty-nine Pounds, Sixteen Shillings and One Penny.

2. The proper officer shall issue and pay such sums of money for the purposes aforesaid not exceeding in the whole the sums hereinbefore specified as the Lieutenant-Governor shall by warrant under his hand direct.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance (No. 1), 1916-1917."
