

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 15 of 1929.

Made under *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland adopted).

The *Mining Regulations* (Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1923), are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting in Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 97 thereof immediately after the words "such marking," the following words "or within such further period as the Warden may upon application in a particular case direct,";
2. By adding at the end of Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 97 thereof the following new proviso:—

"Provided that the Warden may upon application in a particular case dispense with the posting of the true copy of the certificate as aforesaid and direct such other mode of publication in lieu thereof as he thinks fit."
3. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
