

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 15 of 1939.

Made under the *Native Labour Ordinance*, 1911-1933.

The *Native Labour Regulations*, 1933 (Statutory Rules No. 19 of 1933), are further amended as follows :—

1. By inserting in Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 24 immediately after the word "native" first occurring therein the words "under contract of service."

2. By omitting from Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 24 the words :—

"For every in-patient of the hospital, One shilling a day or portion of a day from the time of his admission" and inserting the following in their stead—

"For every in-patient of a native hospital—

Where there is a Government Medical Officer, One shilling and six pence.

Where there is a European Medical Assistant but no Government Medical Officer, One shilling for each day or portion of a day from the time of admission."
