

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 7 of 1932.

Made under the *Native Regulation Ordinance*, 1908-1930.

The *Native Regulations*, 1931 (Statutory Rules No. 7 of 1931), are amended as follows:—

1. By adding at the end of Regulation 81. thereof under the heading *Gambling* the following additional words:—

“Cards being used for gambling may be seized by any Magistrate, member of the Armed Constabulary or Village Constable and upon conviction of an offence under this Regulation the Magistrate may order them to be destroyed or otherwise dealt with at his discretion.”
