

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 13 of 1930.

Made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance* of 1908.

The *Native Regulations*, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1922), are further amended as follows:—

1. By adding immediately after the word “taught” in Sub-regulation (4) of Regulation 96 thereof, the following words:—

“to the satisfaction of an examiner of assisted primary schools or other person appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor.”

2. By adding at the end of Regulation 96 thereof the following new sub-regulation:—

“(6) A certificate under the hand of an examiner of assisted primary schools or other person appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor shall for a period of twelve months from its date be deemed proof that English is taught in the school to which it refers in accordance with Sub-regulation (4) of this regulation.”
