Made under The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908.

The Native Regulations, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1922), are amended by omitting from Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 85A the words "in or in the vicinity of any village" and substituting therefor the words "in any street or public place."
