

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 2 of 1924.

Made under the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance*, 1912-1920.

The *Postal Regulations*, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 22 of 1923) are amended as follows:—

- (1) Regulation 117 and the heading "Mail Notice" is repealed.
- (2) Regulation 118 is repealed and the following Regulation is made in lieu thereof:—

"118. The rates of payment to masters of vessels for the carriage of mails in cases not provided for by contract shall be as follow:—

Letters and post cards	8d. per lb.
Other articles	1s. 4d. per cwt."
