

STATUTORY RULES

No. 15 of 1934.

Made under the *Prisons Ordinance*, 1919-1930.

The *Prisons Regulations*, 1919 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1919) are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting at the end of Regulation 159 the following proviso:—

“Provided that prisoners (other than Europeans) accustomed to living on food different from that represented by the rations prescribed for their particular class under the said Schedule may be supplied with the rations prescribed for any other class under the said Schedule but only upon the order of the Government Secretary.”

Made in Executive Council this twenty-sixth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.
