

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 14 of 1917.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER "THE PUBLIC SERVICE ORDINANCE
OF 1907" (No. 2 of 1907).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Public Officers (Health) Regulations, 1917."

2. Any Officer in the Public Service shall, when called upon so to do by the Lieutenant-Governor or by the Head of his Department, submit himself for medical examination to a Government Medical Officer.

3. The Government Medical Officer who may be required to do so shall make such examination and shall report thereon to the Lieutenant-Governor.

4. The fee for the examination and report shall be paid by the Government.
