

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 1 of 1917.

PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATION.

MADE UNDER "THE PUBLIC SERVICE ORDINANCE OF 1907."

In future, any Officer who fails to furnish the Government Secretary through the Head of his Department with a written notification of the dates of his departure on leave and return to duty will have the sum of Ten shillings (10/-) deducted, in each instance, from his salary.

The Regulation made on 13th June, 1913, and published in *Gazette* No. 11 of 2nd July, 1913, is hereby cancelled.

Passed in Executive Council this twenty-seventh day of December, One thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
