

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 10 of 1940.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907* (No. 2 of 1907).

The *Public Service Regulations, 1939* (Statutory Rules No. 12 of 1939), are further amended as follows:—

1. By adding at the end of the proviso to Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 38 thereof the following further words “or to an officer on active service with His Majesty’s Forces.”

2. By adding at the end of Sub-regulation (5) of Regulation 38 thereof the following further proviso:—

“Provided further that the provisions of this sub-regulation shall not apply to the payment of deferred leave allowance in respect of an officer on active service with His Majesty’s Forces.”

3. (1) By inserting in Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 44 thereof immediately after the word “service” the words “on duty”.

(2) The provisions of this regulation shall be deemed to have applied since the commencement of the said regulations.

4. By adding at the end of Sub-regulation (3) of Regulation 44 thereof the following further words “The provisions of this sub-regulation shall not apply in respect of an officer on active service with His Majesty’s Forces.”

5. (1) By omitting Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 65 thereof and the proviso thereto and inserting the following in their stead:—

“(1) When the whole or part of a building belonging to or in the disposal of the Government of the Territory is provided and made available as a residence for an officer such officer shall be charged a rental not exceeding ten per centum on the minimum salary of the group in which the officer was, or in the case of an officer appointed to the Public Service after the thirtieth day of June, 1926, would have been, classified immediately prior to the classification published in the *Gazette* of the eleventh day of May, 1926, irrespective of the value or condition of the building so occupied: Provided that no rent shall be charged any officer who is allowed free quarters in his classification.”

(2) The provisions of this regulation shall be deemed to have applied since the commencement of the said regulations.
