



STATUTORY RULES. No. 1 of 1932.

Made under the *Samarai Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1926.*

The *Samarai Electricity Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 1 of 1927), are amended as follows:—

1. By inserting immediately after paragraph (c) of Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 2 thereof under the heading "Lighting" the following new paragraph:—

"(d) For all electricity used for lighting upon application by a consumer undertaking to consume not less than 225 Units per month Thirteen pounds for the first 225 Units and all in excess of 225 at the ordinary rate applicable."

2. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
