Boards (Fees and Allowances) Act 1955,

Being an Act to provide for the payment of fees and allowances to members of Boards.

1. INTERPRETATION.

In this Act, “**Board**” means a Board or Committee established or constituted by or under any law, other than the Parliament or a Committee of the Parliament.

2. APPROVED BOARDS.

The Minister may, by notice in the National Gazette, approve a Board for the purposes of this Act.

3. FEES AND ALLOWANCES.

Notwithstanding anything in any law, the Minister may pay to a member of a Board approved under Section 2 (other than a member who is an officer of the Public Service) such fees and allowances as the Minister from time to time determines.
