

**ADMINISTRATION CONTRACTS ORDINANCE  
1951.**<sup>(1) (2)</sup>

**No. 3 of 1951.**

**An Ordinance to amend the Administration Contracts  
Ordinance 1950.**

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua and New Guinea Act 1949-1950*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Administration Contracts Ordinance 1951.*<sup>(1) (2)</sup> Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Administration Contracts Ordinance 1950* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Administration Contracts Ordinance 1950-1951.*

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "Fifteen" and inserting in its stead the word "Twenty-five". Contracts
