72 (1) OF THE LAND ORDINANCE 1922-1950  
PLACING LAND UNDER THE CONTROL OF  
TRUSTEES.**

PROCLAMATION.

*Land Ordinance 1922-1950 of the Territory of New Guinea.*

APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEES.

Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust  
Land at Nondugl.

**W**HEREAS by a Proclamation dated the fifteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, and published in *Gazette* No. 6 dated the first day of March, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, an area of land described in the Schedule thereto was permanently reserved from sale or lease for the purpose of the conducting of the Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust:

And whereas by section 72 of the *Land Ordinance 1922-1950* of the Territory of New Guinea, it is among other things provided that the Administrator may by Proclamation without issuing any deed of grant place any land so reserved under the control of trustees and may declare the style or title of such trustees and the trusts for the carrying out of which such land is placed under their control and may empower such trustees to make by-laws for carrying out the objects of the trust and to impose penalties not exceeding in any case Five pounds for any breach thereof:

And whereas by section 5 of the *Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust Ordinance 1949* it is provided that the persons designated therein shall be the Trustees constituting the Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust established by the said Ordinance:

Now therefore, I, Jack Keith Murray, Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Land Ordinance 1922-1950* of the Territory of New Guinea and all other powers me enabling, do proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule to the Proclamation dated the fifteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, hereinbefore mentioned, is hereby, until this Proclamation shall be revoked, placed for the purpose of the conducting of the Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust in accordance with the provisions of the *Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust Ordinance 1949* under the control of the persons from time to time constituting the Trust in accordance with the said Ordinance, as Trustees under the style or title of the "Trustees of the Hallstrom Live-stock and Fauna (Papua and New Guinea) Trust" upon trust to permit the said land to be used for the purpose hereinbefore mentioned subject to such restrictions and conditions if any as may from time to time be imposed by by-laws hereinafter mentioned:

And I do hereby declare that I empower the said Trustees to make by-laws subject to the approval of the Administrator for carrying out the objects of the said trust and to impose penalties not exceeding in any case Five pounds for any breach thereof.
