Native Labour Ordinance 1946 of the Territory of Papua-New Guinea.

REMOVAL OF NATIVES.

WHEREAS by section 100 of the Native Labour Ordinance 1946 of the Territory of Papua-New Guinea, it is amongst other things provided that the Director of the Department of Native Labour may issue a permit to any person to remove beyond the limits of the Territory any Native employed by such person under Part 9 of the said Ordinance for the purposes set out in the said section:

And whereas by the said section it is further provided that the Administrator may by notice in the Gazette vary or add to the purposes for which permits may be issued under the said section:

Now therefore, I, Jack Keith Murray, the Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by section 100 of the said Ordinance and all other powers me enabling, hereby give notice that permits to remove Natives beyond the territorial limits of the Territory may be given under the said section for the purpose of enabling such Natives to proceed as seamen to the New Hebrides or Fiji or the Island of Borneo and the purposes set out in the said section are hereby added to by including the said purpose.
