1592**PRINTERS AND NEWSPAPERS (PAPUA)
ORDINANCE 1950.⁽¹⁾****No. 14 of 1950.****An Ordinance to amend the Printers and Newspapers
Ordinance, 1913-1935 of the Territory of Papua.**

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua and New Guinea Act 1949*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Printers and Newspapers (Papua) Ordinance 1950.*⁽¹⁾

(2.) The *Printers and Newspapers Ordinance, 1913-1935*⁽²⁾ of the Territory of Papua is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Printers and Newspapers Ordinance 1913-1950.*

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice⁽¹⁾ in the *Gazette*.

Commencement.

3. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the definition of "Registrar" and inserting in its stead the following definition:—

"'Registrar-General' means such officer as the Administrator appoints by notice⁽³⁾ in the *Gazette* to perform the functions of the Registrar-General under this Ordinance." Definitions.

4. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "Registrar of the Central Court" (twice occurring) and inserting in their stead the word "Registrar-General". First Schedule.

5. The Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "Registrar" (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word "Registrar-General". General Amendment.

(3) Pursuant to Section 2, the Administrator, by notice dated 2.9.1950 and published in Papua and N.G. *Govt. Gaz.*, appointed "the person for the time being performing the duties of Registrar-General under the provisions of the Registration of *Births, Deaths and Marriages Ordinance, 1912-1937* of the Territory of Papua to perform the functions of Registrar-General."
