Diseases of Plants Ordinance.

WHEREAS by the *Diseases of Plants Ordinance* 1934, it is provided that the Administrator in Council may make regulations under that Ordinance:

And whereas by the *Diseases of Plants Regulations* 1934⁽²⁾ "Notifiable Disease" means any disease declared by the Administrator by notice to be a notifiable disease:

Now therefore I, Walter Ramsay McNicoll, the Administrator, do hereby declare the following to be notifiable diseases under the Ordinance.

Brontispa (Bronthispa) Spp.	Coconut leaf hispid.
Promecotheca Spp.	Coconut leaf hispid.
Rhyncophorus Spp.	(Coconut) Palm Weevils.
Bunchy Top of Bananas.	Bunchy Top of Bananas.
Sigatoka disease of Bananas.	Sigatoka disease of Bananas.
Sexava Spp.	Coconut tree hopper.
