

POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE 1923-1933. ⁽¹⁾

An Ordinance Relating to the Postal and Telegraphic Services of the Territory.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the *New Guinea Act* 1920, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance* 1923-1933. ⁽¹⁾

2. This Ordinance shall be incorporated and read as one with the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance*, 1912-1916, of Papua in its application to the Territory (in this Ordinance referred to as the Papuan Ordinance).
