POUNDS REGULATIONS 1923.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Regulation 4 of the *Pounds Regulations 1923* I David Sydney Wanliss the Deputy of the Administrator of the Territory of New Guinea and the Officer for the time being administering the Government of the Territory do hereby—

1. Establish a Public Pound at Rabaul Territory of New Guinea such Pound to consist of:—

All that area comprising about seven-tenths of an acre being part of original section 16 Town of Rabaul commencing at a point being the North-Western corner of section 16 aforesaid and bounded on the North by the Northern boundary of section 16 aforesaid bearing Easterly for 100 metres and bounded thence on the East by part of the Eastern boundary of section 16 aforesaid bearing Southerly for 28 metres and bounded thence on the

South by a line bearing Easterly for 100 metres and bounded thence on the West by part of the Western boundary of section 16 aforesaid bearing Northerly for 28 metres to the point of commencement.

2. Appoint Bernard William Sherman⁽¹⁾ of Rabaul to be Poundkeeper of the said Public Pound.

POUNDS REGULATIONS 1923.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Regulation 4 of the *Pounds Regulations* 1923 I David Sydney Wanliss the Deputy of the Administrator of the Territory of New Guinea and the Officer for the time being administering the Government of the Territory do hereby:—

1. Establish a Public Pound at Aitape, Territory of New Guinea, such Pound to consist of:—

All that piece or parcel of land situated in the Town of Aitape containing an area of four-fifths of an acre or thereabouts, commencing at a point on the left bank of the Aitape River being the South-west corner of the land occupied under the Trading Allotment Licence No. 459 and bounded on the North-east by a line forming the South-west boundary of the land occupied under the trading allotment aforesaid bearing North-westerly for 4 chains to the South Eastern side of the Pultutul Road and bounded on the North-west by the South-east side of that road bearing South-Westerly for 2 chains and bounded on the South-west by a line bearing South-easterly for 4 chains to a point on the left bank of the Aitape River aforesaid and bounded thence on the South-east by the left bank of that river downwards bearing North-easterly to the point of commencement.

2. Appoint George de Louis Gouday⁽²⁾ of Aitape to be Poundkeeper of the said Public Pound.

1. Establish a Pound at Wau, Territory of New Guinea, such Pound to consist of—

All that piece of land containing 8 ares 45 square metres more or less situated in the Town of Wau in the Administrative District of Morobe, commencing at a marked point on the north-easterly side of a road 20 metres wide bearing magnetic 42 degrees 52 minutes and distant 20 and 2/100 metres from the north-eastern corner of Lot 24 of Section A of the said Town of Wau and bounded thence on the south-west by part of the north-eastern side of the said road being a line bearing magnetic 310 degrees for 34 metres thence on the north-west by a line bearing magnetic 40 degrees for 15 and 6/100 metres thence on the north by a line bearing 100 degrees for 39 and 27/100 metres thence on the south-east by a line bearing magnetic 220 degrees for 34 and 68/100 metres to the point of commencement.

All that piece of land containing 21 ares 23 square metres more or less situated at Kokopo and being part of Portion 22 of the Administrative District of New Britain commencing at a marked point being the northernmost corner of Portion 22 aforesaid and bounded thence on the north by the northern boundary of the said Portion 22 being a line bearing magnetic 105 degrees 45 minutes for 2 and 2/100 metres thence on the north-east by part of the north-eastern boundary of the said Portion 22 being part of a south-western side of a road 10 metres wide being a line bearing magnetic 129 degrees 33 minutes for 70 metres thence on the south-east by a line bearing magnetic 219 degrees 33 minutes for 40 metres thence on the south-west by a line bearing magnetic 313 degrees 35 minutes for 47 and 98/100 metres to a point on a common boundary between the said Portion 22 and a property known as Kenabot Plantation thence on the west by part of the said common boundary being a line bearing magnetic 1 degree 52 minutes for 40 metres to the point of commencement.
