

REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS, AND MARRIAGES REGULATIONS. ⁽¹⁾

- Short title.** 1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Regulations*.⁽¹⁾
- Definitions.** 2.—(1.) In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
 “Ordinance” means the *Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Ordinance 1935*.⁽²⁾
 (2.) Any reference in these Regulations to a form shall be read as a reference to a form in the First Schedule to these Regulations.
- Fees.** 3. The fees to be charged under the Ordinance shall be as set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.
- Form of certification under section 14 of Ordinance.** 4. A certification under sub-section (1.) or sub-section (2.) of section 14 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 1.
- Particulars of birth.**
Am. by 1936 No. 16, r. 1. 5. The particulars for registration to be furnished under sections 24, 25, and 30 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 2.
- Particulars of birth on vessel.** 6.—(1.) The particulars of a birth to be furnished under section 26 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 3.
 (2.) The statutory declaration verifying such particulars may be made before a person authorized by section 26 of the Ordinance to receive such particulars.
- Statutory declaration under section 30 of Ordinance.** 7. The statutory declaration under section 30 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 4.

(1) The *Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Regulations* (made under the *Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Ordinance 1935-1941*) comprise the original *Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Regulations*, as amended by the other Regulation referred to in the following Table:—

Registration of Births, Deaths, and Marriages Regulations.

8. Except as otherwise provided, the particulars to be furnished of a death occurring in the Territory shall be in accordance with Form 5. Particulars of death in Territory.

9.—(1.) The particulars of a death to be furnished under section 42 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 6. Particulars of death on vessel.

(2.) The statutory declaration verifying such particulars may be made before a person authorized by section 42 of the Ordinance to receive such particulars.

10. The medical certificate of death under section 38 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 7. Form of medical certificate of death.

11. The notification of a coroner's finding under section 40 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 8. Form of notification of result of inquest.

12. The certificate of registration of a death under section 41 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 9. Form of certificate of registration to be furnished to undertaker.

13. The District Registrar to whom particulars in regard to any birth, death, or marriage are furnished under the Ordinance shall record those particulars in the manner prescribed. Particulars to be recorded.

14.—(1.) Where, under section 21 of the Ordinance, the Registrar-General directs the registration of any birth, death, or marriage to be cancelled, the registration shall be cancelled by making an entry, in accordance with Form 10, in the margin of the register opposite the registration. Cancellation of false or illegal registration.

(2.) Where, under the direction of the Registrar-General, a District Registrar has cancelled a registration, he shall notify the Registrar-General and forward him a copy of the entry cancelling the registration, and the Registrar-General shall thereupon insert a copy of the entry in the margin of his duplicate of the registration and note in the appropriate index that the registration has been cancelled.
