

CRIMINAL LAW—

ALLOWANCES TO WITNESSES IN CRIMINAL  
CASES REGULATIONS, 1924. <sup>(1)</sup>

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Allowances to Witnesses in Criminal Cases Regulations, 1924.*<sup>(1)</sup>

2. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fourteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four.

3. The regulations made under *The Criminal Procedure Ordinance of 1889*, dated the nineteenth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and five, and published in *Gazette No. 14, Vol. XVIII*, are hereby repealed.

SCALE OF ALLOWANCES TO WITNESSES IN CRIMINAL CASES.

4. Travelling expenses reasonably incurred and one pound for every day or part of a day for maintenance shall be allowed to—

- (1) all Crown witnesses at the Court of Petty Sessions;
- (2) all Crown witnesses at the Central Court;<sup>(2)</sup>
- (3) witnesses for the defence at the Central Court,<sup>(2)</sup> if certified by the presiding Judge to be necessary and material.

5. No allowance for maintenance will be made—

- (1) where travelling expenses include maintenance, as for instance, in the case of steamer fares;
- (2) where the witness is kept at the Government expense.

6. No allowance will be made for loss of time.

(1) The *Allowances to Witnesses in Criminal Cases Regulations, 1924* (made under the *Criminal Procedure Ordinance, 1889-1939*) comprise the original *Allowances to Witnesses in Criminal Cases Regulations, 1924*, as amended by the other Regulations referred to in the following Table:—
