

RULES PUBLICATION ORDINANCE, 1916.⁽¹⁾

No. 1 of 1916.

An Ordinance for the Publication of Statutory Rules.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rules Publication Ordinance, 1916.*⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2. In this Ordinance—

“Statutory Rules” means rules regulations or by-laws made under any Ordinance which—

- (a) relate to any court or to the procedure practice or costs therein or to any fees or matters applying generally throughout the Territory or any part of the Territory; or

- (b) are made by the Lieutenant-Governor⁽²⁾ or by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.⁽²⁾

“Rule-making Authority” includes every authority authorized to make any statutory rules.

3.—(1.) All statutory rules made after the commencement of this Ordinance shall forthwith after they are made be sent to the Government Printer and shall in manner prescribed by regulation under this Ordinance be numbered and printed and sold by him.

(2.) Any statutory rules may without prejudice to any other mode of citation be cited by the number so given and the calendar year.

(3.) Regulations under this Ordinance may prescribe the classes of cases in which the exercise of a statutory power by any rule-making authority constitutes or does not constitute the making of a statutory rule within the meaning of this section.

4. Any printed paper purporting to be a copy of statutory rules made by a rule-making authority and to be printed by the Government Printer shall in all courts within the Territory be evidence that such statutory rules have been duly made by the rule-making authority and are in force.
