Being a Prices Order relating to the display of prices for aerated waters.

MADE by the Price Controller under the Prices Regulation Act 1949 to come into operation on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.

1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 187.

Prices Order No. 187-continued

2. DEFINITION.

In this Order "retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

3. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

Any person or organization engaged in selling aerated waters by retail shall display in their respective place of business in a prominent position in close proximity to such aerated waters a placard, sign or notice setting forth in large, clear and legible figures the maximum price at which those aerated waters may be bought.

- 6. Subject to the Act, the registration of the Enterprise is for three years from the date of registration but may be extended by the Minister on the application of the Enterprise.
- 7. If at the expiration of nine months from the date of registration the Enterprise has not commenced carrying on business in any of the activities for which it is hereby registered, the registration of the Enterprise shall thereupon cease and determine in respect of those activities.
- 8. The Enterprise shall guide and assist Papua New Guinean enterprises in establishing business in ancillary activities.
- 9. The Enterprise shall use sources of supply and services within Papua New Guinea, preferably Papua New Guinean owned, unless the required supplies and services are not readily available at comparable prices and of similar quality in Papua New Guinea.
- 10. The Enterprise shall at all times conduct its operations in such a way as to minimise deleterious effects on the environment and shall abide by any reasonable standards specified by the Minister responsible for environmental matters.
- 11. The proprietors for the time being of the Enterprise shall not transfer or offer to transfer any interest in the Enterprise without first notifying NIDA in writing.
- 12. The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of the Minister establish a place of business in any location in Papua New Guinea other than Port Moresby.
- 13. The Enterprise shall within twelve months of the date of registration enter into discussions with Papua New Guinean suppliers of the beche-de-mer and with the Office of Business Development, with the objective of introducing Papua New Guinean participation and developing Papua New Guinean expertise, including marketing and financial administration expertise, in the activity for which the Enterprise is registered.
 - 14. All beche-de-mer will be purchased from Papua New Guinean suppliers.
- 15. Before purchasing from Papua New Guineans for the first time, the Enterprise shall at a special meeting of those Papua New Guineans who have use rights to the particular reef area, fully explain its proposed activities.
- 16. At the expiration of one month from the date of registration and at monthly intervals thereafter, the Enterprise shall submit to the Fisheries Division of the Department of Primary Industries and NIDA:
 - (a) records of the species of beche-de-mer purchased by it during that period;
 - (b) prices paid to the collectors;
 - (c) prices obtained for beche-de-mer exported;
 - (d) areas where collection is being carried out.
- 17. No beche-de-mer shall be collected on any reef by the Enterprise or its employees. The Enterprise shall purchase only beche-de-mer collected by interested Papua New Guineans on a contract basis and the Enterprise shall assist such fishermen in improving methods of collection, processing and storage.
- 18. This registration is for the collection carried out at Hula, Tubusereia, Porebada and Delena Villages, and no other location unless approval is given by NIDA after consultation with the Office of Fisheries, Office of Business Development and the local people from where further collection is to be carried out.

Unless otherwise determined by the Minister, Papua New Guineans or local enterprises shall by the fifth anniversary of the date of registration and at all times thereafter hold and beneficially own shares having the right to not less than 75% of the votes at a general meeting of the Enterprise and the right to appoint directors of the Enterprise not less than in proportion to their equity holding.
- 6. Subject to the Act, the registration of the Enterprise is for five years from the date of registration but may be extended from time to time by the Minister on the application of the Enterprise.

Schedule-continued

- 7. If at the expiration of nine months from the date of registration the Enterprise has not commenced carrying on business in any of the activities for which it is hereby registered, the registration of the Enterprise shall thereupon cease and determine in respect of those activities.
- 8. The Enterprise shall use sources of supply and services within Papua New Guinea, preferably Papua New Guinean owned, unless the required supplies and services are not readily available at comparable prices and of similar quality in Papua New Guinea.
- The Enterprise shall at all times conduct its operations in such a way as to minimise deleterious effects on the environment and shall abide by any reasonable standards specified by the Minister responsible for environmental matters.
- 10. The Enterprise shall not register any transfer of its shares until NIDA has been notified in writing of the transfer.
- 11. The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of the Minister carry on the activities for which it is registered in any location in Papua New Guinea other than Port Moresby.
- 12. The Enterprise shall consult with Papua New Guinean employees before management decisions relating to the terms and conditions of employment of such employees are made.
