Such notice shall not be given before the fourth anniversary of the date of registration.

2. As practical and appropriate, provision shall be made by the Enterprise for Papua New Guinean investment in, and participation in the ownership, management and control of the Enterprise. Control of the Enterprise shall be transferred to Papua New Guinean hands as soon as practicable and reasonable, having regard to the nature of the Enterprise and its activities. NIDA will consider this requirement to have been complied with throughout the first four years of the period of registration of the Enterprise if Papua New Guineans or local enterprises acquire and thereafter retain beneficial ownership of at least 50% of the Enterprise by the third anniversary of the date of registration.

3. The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of the Minister establish a place of business in any location in Papua New Guinea other than Portion 552, Six Mile, Port Moresby.

4. The Enterprise will comply with all and any obligations and conditions relating to the training of employees and the localisation of its staff (including both employees and officers of the Enterprise) which may from time to time be laid down by the Department of Labour and Industry (or any other Department which succeeds to the functions of that Department) or prescribed or declared under the *Employment (Training and Regulation) Act* as in force from time to time dealing with training and localisation of staff.

5. If without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not at the expiration of six months from the date of registration commenced carrying on business in any of the activities for which it is hereby registered, the registration of the Enterprise shall thereupon cease and determine in respect of those activities.

6. The Enterprise shall guide and assist Papua New Guinean enterprises in establishing businesses in activities ancillary to the registered activities.
