**GENERAL PRICES (AMENDMENT No. 79) ORDER 1986**

being

A Prices Order to amend the General Prices Order 1983.

MADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the *Prices Regulation Act* (Chapter 320) to come into operation on 6th March, 1986.

**AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 8.**

Schedule 8 of the General Prices (Amendment 77) Order 1985 is amended by increasing the amounts appearing under Column 1 under the heading of Motor Spirit maximum price per litre by 0.8, under Column 2 under the heading of Distillate maximum price per litre by 0.7 and under Column 3 under the heading of Lighting Kerosene maximum price per litre by 0.8.

The effect of this Order is to reflect the increase in the general import levy to 7.5% announced in the 1986 Budget.

The effect of this Order is to increase the maximum retail price of aviation gasoline by 1.4 toea per litre to reflect the increase in the general import levy to 7.5% which was announced in the 1986 Budget.

The above prices exclude fuel flowage fees introduced on 4th October, 1982 by the Minister for Transport and Civil Aviation in accordance with the *Aerodrome (Business Concessions) Act 1978*.
