REDUCED RATE OF IMPORT DUTY

I, Dennis Young, C.M.G., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(b) of the Customs Tariff Act 1990 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby Reduce the rate of import duty on the goods described in Column 2 of the Schedule to the rate shown in Column 3 opposite the description.
